Jody Heymann, MD, PhD is the Dean of the UCLA Fielding School of Public Health and Founding Director of the WORLD Policy Analysis Center. An unprecedented effort to improve the level and quality of comparative policy data available to policymakers, researchers and the public, WORLD examines health and social policies and outcomes in all 193 UN countries.

Dr. Heymann previously held a Canada Research Chair in Global Health and Social Policy at McGill University where she was the founding director of the Institute for Health and Social Policy. While on the faculty at Harvard Medical School and the Harvard School of Public Health, she founded the Project on Global Working Families.

Dr. Heymann has authored and edited more than 250 publications, including 17 books. Selected titles include *Changing Children’s Chances* (Harvard University Press, 2013), *Making Equal Rights Real* (Cambridge University Press, 2012), *Lessons in Educational Equality* (Oxford University Press, 2012), *Protecting Childhood in the AIDS Pandemic* (Oxford University Press, 2012), *Profit at the Bottom of the Ladder* (Harvard Business Press, 2010), *Raising the Global Floor*(Stanford University Press, 2009), *Trade and Health* (McGill Queens University Press, 2007), *Forgotten Families* (Oxford University Press, 2006), and *Healthier Societies* (Oxford University Press, 2006).

Dr. Heymann has received numerous honors, including election to the national Institute of Medicine in 2013 and the Canadian Academy of Health Sciences in 2012. She has worked with leaders in North American, European, African, and Latin American governments as well as a wide range of intergovernmental organizations including the World Health Organization, the International Labor Organization, the World Economic Forum, UNICEF, and UNESCO.
