Jonathan Bradshaw took his first degree at Trinity College Dublin and obtained an MPhil and DPhil at the University of York in 1967. He was appointed a lecturer there in 1969. He was founding Director of the Social Policy Research Unit from 1973 to 1987 and served two terms as Head of Department 1988-1994 and 2003-2007. He also served as Director of the Institute for Research in the Social Sciences 1994-1998. He was appointed Academician of the Learned Societies for the Social Sciences in 1996, Commander of the British Empire (CBE) in 2005 for services to child poverty and Fellow of the British Academy in 2010. In 2011 he was made Doctor of the University of Turku, Finland (*honoris causa*) and in 2015 Doctor of the University Bath, England (*honoris causa*).
